









Friday 27th September



-  Children must **ARRIVE AT SCHOOL FOR 9.30 a.m.** (please do not arrive before 9.30 a.m. due to the congestion around school at the start of the day)
-  **Cases must be left outside the Office area** – (along the wall by the window) we will try to provide cover for the cases in the event of rain
-  **A packed lunch and drink is required**, which will be eaten on arrival at PGL (please provide in a disposal bag)
-  Children should wear casual clothing appropriate for the weather and sensible footwear as they will be taking part in an activity on arrival at PGL – so dress accordingly!
-  **PARENTS AND PUPILS must 'check in'** in Dean Hall – at the **BANK STATION** to deposit spending money - a maximum of £15 (maximum) is permitted. Money must be in three separate named envelopes (preferably coins or £5 notes). The Office is unable to provide change on the day as we are now cashless! We operate a bank system at PGL where the children can withdraw money each day.
-  If there are any medical issues please register at the **MEDICAL STATION** to hand in medication and the fully completed Administer Medicine Form (available from the website or outside the Office).
-  The last stop is **saying your 'goodbye' to your** child at the **REGISTRATION STATION**. Children will then go through to class – **taking their packed lunch and waterproof jacket/coat** with them.

MEDICATION: If your child needs a travel sickness tablet for the journey, please administer this prior to arriving at School (as most last for 24 hours). For the return journey, please provide medication in an envelope, with dosage noted. **ALL MEDICATION** must be clearly labelled with the child's name. We can only accept medication in original packaging.

-  The coach will leave School from (approximately) **10.15 a.m.** onwards once loaded.

Reminders:

- **No mobile telephones, iWatches, iPads, iPods, electronic games etc. can be taken**
- Children will need to bring a total of three 'named' black sack bags for dirty clothes and two for their sleeping bag (which includes one for the return journey).

-  Arrival at PGL approximately **12.30 p.m.** followed by lunch
-  Followed by a welcome talk, safety induction, unpacking and a guided orientation tour

Strict procedures have to be followed to ensure that each activity is run safely and there are certain areas that are out of bounds. Please talk to your child before they leave about the importance of obeying instructions at all times without argument, for their own safety.
